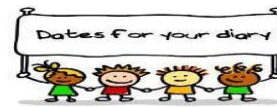

## Making Learning More Memorable

Hogwarts' topic this term is based around the question "How can we limit climate change?" The class completed the 'Beat the Flood' challenge for their Big Bang. They designed, built and tested their own model houses. Their brief was to create strong, flood proof homes.



The children will go on to learn about the differences between climate and weather, how climate change is measured and the impact of climate change in the environment.

In Reception, this term's theme is "Ocean Treasure." The children dressed for an afternoon at the beach! They have made boats and explored if they are waterproof and if they float (or not!). The children were in awe watching real filming of sea creatures in the ocean.
