

### Key Stage One SATs

Along with the reintroduction of SATs for children at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6), the government have reinstated the end of Key Stage 1 SATs. Although these are formal tests, they are done in a relaxed way; in fact, most children are not even aware they're taking a test! They are not timed, Mr Roberts will stop the activities when he feels it is appropriate for the child. These are marked by class teachers. We use the information to help plan future learning to address any gaps in understanding and plan in any support needed for individual pupils.

### Well done Year 6!

A huge well done to year 6. Standard Assessment Tasks (SATs) for all pupils in Year 6 have been reintroduced nationally. We were so impressed with the children's resilience and focus. The tests have to be administered under strict exam conditions. Pupils and parents will receive their results with their end of year school reports. Thank you to staff who supported the children and provided breakfast prior to the tests.
