FSA Easter Egg Hunt

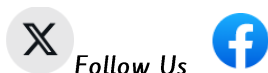

The app also displays a full list of services available at each site, as well as parking and opening time information.

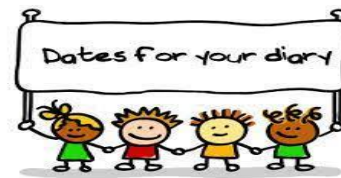
